

Evacuation of Indoor Motorsports Arenas

The owner and/or operator <u>must</u> evacuate a motorsports arena if:

- CO levels continuously exceed 83 ppm or NO2 levels continuously exceed 2.0 ppm for 15 minutes
- CO levels continuously exceed 30 ppm or NO2 levels continuously exceed 0.3 ppm for 2 hours

Evacuation Steps:

- 1. Contact the local fire department ASAP to request assistance
- 2. Evacuate the arena
- 3. Contact MDH upon completing evacuation
- 4. MDH Indoor Air Unit Hotline: 651-201-4601. If after hours, press 3 and leave a message.
- 5. Conduct air quality test every 15 minutes until acceptable air quality is achieved.
- 6. Acceptable air quality conditions and corrective actions must be verified by the local fire department or MDH.
- 7. Reoccupy arena.
- 8. Test air at 15 minute intervals for at least 1 hour per day for the next 3 days of operation
- 9. Submit a report to MDH within 5 business days that includes:
 - Explanation of why corrective action was necessary
 - A description of the immediate corrective actions taken
 - A record of all air quality tests taken
 - An action plan to prevent a reoccurrence
