Rule Language Discussion

A. Rule Revision Topics

- i. Self-employment or independent contracting evidence defined (.2600 Subp. 10), plus corresponding Track 2 (.2930 Subp. 3B)
- Jim explained MDH definition of self-employment or independent contracting evidence to the Council.
 - ii. Internship (.2930 Subp.2B)
- Jim informed the Council that this language was added for clarity.
 - iii. Renewal expiration date (.2950 Subp. 1 7)
- Jim informed the Council that this language was added under the heading Terms.
 - iv. Terms (.2955 Subp. A-E)
- Jim read and reviewed the new Terms language to the Council.
 - v. Disciplinary Actions (.2960 Subp. 2D)
- The Council reviewed the Disciplinary Actions language. Linda informed the Council that the language prohibiting someone from using the REHS/RS credential when their credential is not active should be placed under subpart 4. Linda then raised the question as to what do we do when a REHS/RS is in their "grace period", are they still an REHS/RS? Linda recommended that we rethink the disciplinary actions using the Health Enforcement Consolidation Act (HECA).

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B. Variance - Linda

- Linda asked the Council if they saw a need for a variance to this rule? If so, then she recommended to reference language from 4717.7000, ,7020, and .7030. Linda then asked where in the rule would we not grant a variance?
