If you want to prepare a press release or communicate with the media about a recent detection of an unregulated contaminant, coordinate with MDH and be prepared with the following information:

		quality, routine monitoring, special monitoring event, etc.)
	0	How the contaminant entered the drinking water system
	0	Geographical area affected
	0	Agency in charge of the situation and other partners working to resolve the
		situation
	0	Actions being taken to monitor or resolve the situation
	Health and safety information	
	0	Known health effects if people drink the water
		 Distinguish between acute and chronic effects
	0	Populations at risk
	0	Recommended actions for customers
	When more information will be available
