Dear Mr. McClean,

This letter is to provide formal notice that the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) has received sufficient information to complete a public interest review of Regions Hospital's proposal to add 45 licensed beds at an existing safety net, level I trauma hospital in Ramsey County, Minnesota.

As you know, MDH may take up to 150 days to issue a finding on whether the proposed increase in the number of beds is in the public interest. During this time, we will also publish a notice in the state register, reach out to affected parties, and request public comment.
