# Native American Community Clinic Community Testing Demographics

These demographics and results are for testing completed June 27, 2020 at Harding High School, St. Paul, MN.

The State of Minnesota, in partnership with Native American Community Clinic and M Health Fairview, offered COVID-19 testing at Harding High School, St. Paul, MN.

- Testing was open to everyone. Residents of neighboring communities were eligible to be tested.
  People who lived further away were encouraged to find a local clinic before registering.
- People with and without symptoms were tested.
- Testing was free, no insurance was needed.
- Pre-registration was encouraged and could be done online and by phone.
- Testing was administered by professional medical staff.

#### Positivity rate: 2.95%

- 237 people were tested.
- 7 people were confirmed positive (cases).

## **Symptoms**


57% of those who tested positive did not have symptoms at the time of testing. This speaks to the importance of staying home and isolating if you believe you were exposed and wearing a mask and washing your hands to reduce potential spread.


