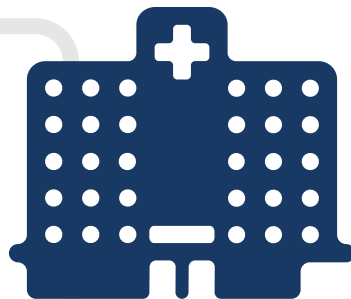


# How Would Minnesota Handle a Case of Ebola?

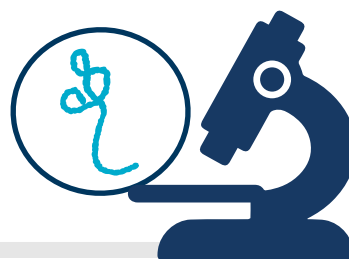
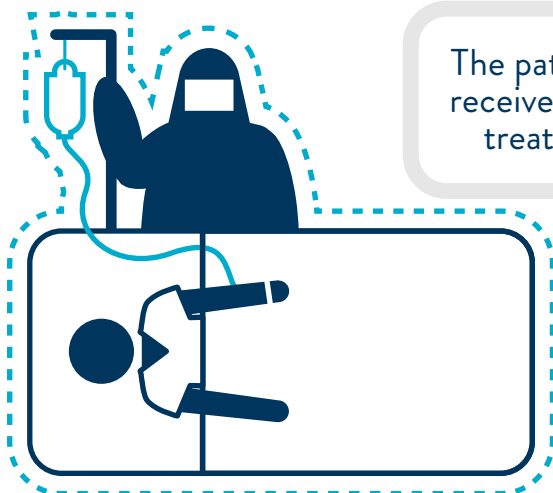
A person is exposed to Ebola and has symptoms.



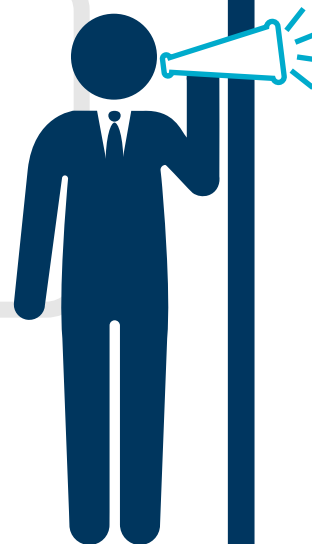
The person is admitted to a hospital that specializes in caring for someone with Ebola.
