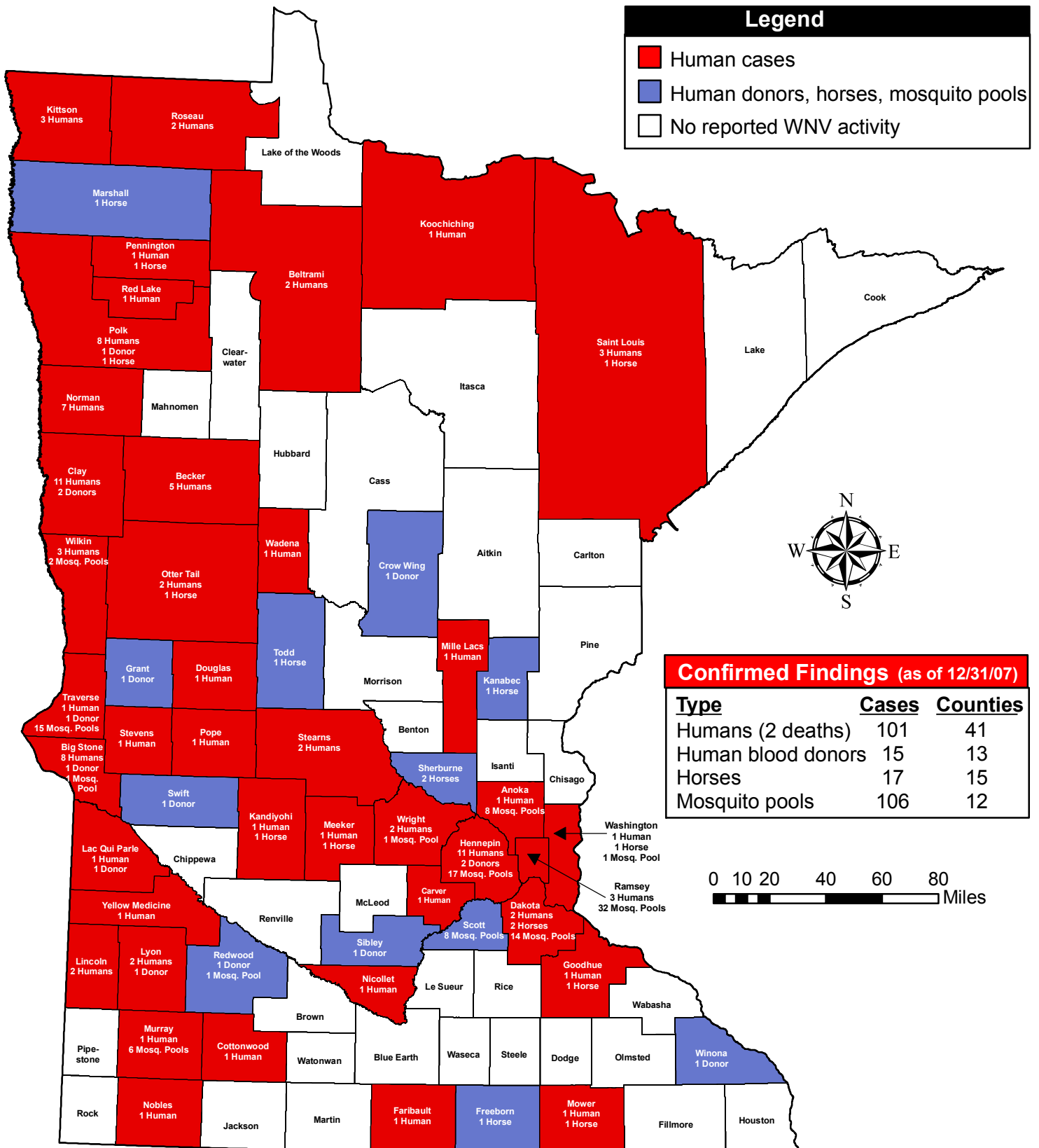


Minnesota West Nile Virus Monitoring, 2007



The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) monitors mosquito populations in six counties in western and southwestern Minnesota: Big Stone, Murray, Ottertail, Redwood, Traverse, and Wilkin. MDH no longer routinely tests birds for West Nile virus (WNV) in Minnesota.
