REVISION POLICY FOR THE FIRE/LIFE SAFETY CODE DOCUMENT GUIDE

Documents developed for the Fire/Life Safety Code Documentation Guide are subject to revision without notice. These changes may occur because of changes to National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard 101 (Life Safety Code, 2012 edition), mandatory references in the Life Safety Code, changes in the Minnesota State Fire Code (MSFC), 2015 edition, and/or changes in interpretation of the provisions of any of these Codes.

Changes to these documents will be noted as follows:

- 1. The index page of the Fire/Life Safety Code Documentation Guide will note the date of revision behind the specific document. For example, following the document title, (revised MM-DD-YY) will be added. Only the date of the most recent revision will be noted.
- 2. Within each specific revised document (narrative, policy, form, etc.), all most recent revisions to the language will be <u>underlined</u>. Underlining will be removed from any revision made prior to the most recent. This will make it easy to assure that your copy is up-to-date.
