- Welcome and introductions by Co-Chair Sen. Mark Koran
- Sen. Mark Koran moved approval of minutes from July 2020, Motion prevailed
- General program update given by Chris Tholkes
 - Shared preliminary results from Patient Satisfaction Survey, cost of registration and products a significant barrier for patients and MN has by far the highest registration fee in US

- 2021 Legislation
 - 2021 legislative update given by Darin Teske
 - Overview of policy proposals, update on rulemaking progress for dried raw cannabis
 - MDH would like explicit authority on track and trace system
 - Addition of edibles to program as approved delivery method
 - Dried raw cannabis updates from manufacturers
 - Kyle Kingsley, MD gave update from Vireo Health
 - Priority to lower prices with addition of dried raw cannabis, dependent on patient demand
 - Buck McAlpin gave update from Leafline Industries
 - Leafline sold to Green Thumb Industries, looking at adding a large grow facility in Cottage Grove
 - Dried raw cannabis update from testing labs
 - Tom Barrett (Legend) and Roger Pearson (Aspen) both have concern about labs being required to do all sampling
- Challenges/issues and proposed policy solutions
 - Rep. Rod Hamilton What can we do to put pressure on federal gov't. to change scheduling of cannabis (cannabis users considered criminals to feds)
 - Sen. Mark Koran Concerns about Delta-8 products being sold widely
 - Maren Schroeder Delta-9 from hemp not regulated or tested, scared CBD products will be pulled from shelves, would like to task force to hold meeting on hemp products
 - Erin Chase Concerns about outside CBD products being sold in CPCs
 - Maren Schroeder Working on legislation to protect patients from employment discrimination, and allowing patients to defend any criminal charges with their patient status
 - Erin Chase Can we further discuss the current situation of only 2 manufacturers being allowed in MN? Would like to allow for more but still be MN-focused. Can we revisit being able to put strain names on packaging for patients to better understand what they are using?

Action items

- Legislators asked to bring any bills being presented on cannabis to the task force so all are aware
- Consider doing smaller workgroups before next task force meeting to discuss adding manufacturers and changes to packaging – Rep. Edelson and Tholkes to meet about this
